



INTRAMURAL SPORTS CAMPUS CUP

The Point System is a competition awarding the most successful University of Arizona Greek Organization(s), Residence Hall and Independent Team for excelling in all aspects of Intramural Sports. This includes but is not limited to the following: participation, sportsmanship & success in competition. Teams and/or individuals must adhere to the following guidelines to be eligible to accumulate points:

ELIGIBILITY

- All **Greek organizations**, as recognized by the University of Arizona & in good standing, are eligible to earn points in any intramural sports league or tournament event.
- All **Residence Halls**, as recognized by the University of Arizona, are eligible to earn points in any intramural sports league or tournament event.
- All **Independent teams** are eligible to earn points in any intramural sport or tournament event.

AWARDS

- Championship Trophy Cup:
 - Overall Men's Greek Organization having accumulated the most points
 - Overall Women's Greek Organization having accumulated the most points
 - Overall Residence Hall having accumulated the most points
 - Overall Independent Team having accumulated the most points
- All Championship Trophy Cups will remain on display at the Department of Campus Recreation's Sports Office.

STIPULATIONS

- **All team names must be the same for every sport in order to accumulate points.**
- All teams interested in competing must state their intent to participate, at the time of registration of each league sport.
 - There will be no accumulation of points for previous seasons if you did not state your intent to participate in that previous season.
- All Greek and Res Hall teams must include a part of their organization in the team name (ex: Theta Chi All-Stars, D-Chi Dominators, Likins Ballers, etc.)
- All participating individuals representing a Greek Organization must be a member of that organization, active & in good standing to participate in extracurricular activities.
- All participating individuals representing a Residence Hall must be a resident of that hall & in good standing with the Residence Life Staff.
- Points will be accumulated for multiple teams/individuals in each sport, but will be half the amount for each team beyond the first.



POINT SCORING SYSTEM

Category	Team sports	Singles/Doubles sports
League participation points:	150 points for each team registered	50 points for each team registered
League competition points:	10 points for each win	10 points for each win
League sportsmanship points:	30 points for averaging a 5.0 20 points for averaging a 4.5-5.0 10 points for averaging a 4.0-4.5	15 points for averaging a 5.0 10 points for averaging a 4.5-5.0 5 points for averaging a 4.0-4.5
League post season points:	20 points for each playoff win	20 points for each playoff win
Tournament points:	100 points per team registered 10 points for each win	50 points per team registered 5 points for each win
End of season points:	50 points for winning the championship 35 points for finishing second 15 points for 3 rd and 4 th place finishes	25 points for winning the championship 15 points for finishing second
Penalties:	-50 points for each forfeit (all points forfeited after the 2 nd forfeit) -10 points for each default -10 points for each technical/yellow card -20 points for each player ejection	-25 points for each forfeit (all points forfeited after the 2 nd forfeit) -10 points for each default
Fan counts:	1 point per fan that checks in (max. of 10 points per game/day)	1 point per fan that checks in (max. of 10 points per game/day)
Social media points:	10 points for each approved picture that gets posted on our Facebook page (max. 1 per week)	

Note: Any team removed permanently from league play due to conduct related issues or having 2 or more forfeits for a single sport will forfeit all points accumulated within that sport; this decision will be made by the Intramural Sports Coordinator.

In the event of a tie in the overall points structure, the winning team will be determined by the following:

1. Total number of championships won
2. Overall average sportsmanship rating in all sports combined
3. Total number of wins in all sports combined (including playoffs)
