Experience the breathtaking beauty of a living and growing cave! Kartchner Caverns is a limestone cave filled with remarkable formations that are still developing before your very eyes. It is also home to a massive 58-foot column formation and the second largest cave straw in the world!

Take a guided tour to learn about this unique cave system and its furry inhabitants. If you're lucky, you might even receive a cave kiss! After exploring the enthralling depths of the caverns, we will make our way through the gorgeous expanse of Guindani canyon and up to the peak of the Guindani trail which offers a breathtaking view of the San Pedro river valley.
