

Camp and Hike Flagstaff, AZ



Join us for an unforgettable camping and hiking trip in Flagstaff, where we'll head up Mount Humphreys, Arizona's highest peak! Our journey begins with a peaceful night of camping beneath the stars in the cool pines of the Coconino National Forest.

The next day, we'll set out on the 10.4-mile Humphreys Peak Trail, climbing over 3,000 feet in elevation. As we hike through alpine meadows and navigate rugged switchbacks, the landscape unfolds before us, leading to the summit at 12,633 feet with sweeping views of Northern Arizona. This adventure is perfect for dedicated hikers looking to experience the beauty and challenge of Arizona's tallest mountain.

Itinerary

Day One:

- Meet at Outdoor Recreation (OR)
- Drive to Flagstaff
- Stop for food on the way
- Arrive at campsite, set-up camp
- 5-minute initiative, a chance to give back to the natural areas around us

Day Two:

- Breakfast, pack a lunch
- Head to the Mt. Humphreys Trailhead and begin hiking
- Lunch at the peak
- Return to campsite
- Eat dinner

Day Three:

- Eat breakfast at campsite
- Go to a souvenier shop and explore downtown Flagstaff
- Pack-up and drive to Tucson
- Stop for lunch in Phoenix
- Head back to OR
